We have a few new and exciting changes this year and are so excited to share them with you! Please be sure to check out all the changes happening at Camp Garrett, as there are a few policy and tuition changes. *All changes and new items are listed in this newsletter.*

We are excited to introduce our Agriculture Education Track Program!

The best of both worlds at Camp Garrett! Over the last few years, Garrett Williamson's Agriculture Education department has offered Barn Camp for five weeks during the summer, separate from Camp Garrett. Barn Camp offered programming that included animal care, nature hikes, and water play, serving ages 5 through 10.

This year, we are offering a new opportunity for **ages 8 to 12** to explore Agriculture Education with specialized lessons in Barn and Garden Education. Smaller group sizes, with an older age group, allows us the opportunity to offer a more intimate experience focusing on our specialized curriculum. On the next page, you will find information about our farm, animals, and safety features.

The GW Educational Production Farm includes both the VEG (Videon Educational Garden) and the Barn, where the Farm Animals are housed. The Animals living here, and the Plants growing here, all serve a purpose.

We will be working with tools & equipment, walking on uneven terrain, and caring for large animals, most of whom weigh more than an adult! This means there are inherent risks when participating in these programs. The AgEd Track will teach Campers how to safely approach and engage with Farm Animals, properly use Farm tools, and understand the level of care needed for healthy Animals and Plants! With all activities, we emphasize consent by practicing safety & respect.

Our 1/2-acre garden produces vegetables, fruits, herbs, flowers, grains, fibers, dyes, mushrooms, and supports an apiary.

The Barn is home to the following Animals:

* Five Alpacas – Gerty, Laila, Edith, Josephyn, & Sophia * Four Goats – Maggie, Daisy, Dahlia, Daffy * Willow, our Horse

GW Barn Safety Rules

* Calm Bodies – no yelling; soft hands

* Walking Feet - no running, chasing animals

* **Observation Eyes** – not walking behind animals, knowing where the animals are in the pastures, staying with a Grown-Up, navigating uneven terrain.

* Listening Ears – "Stop" or "Freeze", sounds from animals (are they scared?)

What other changes are occurring this year?

Registration Fee

The non-refundable registration fee has increased from **\$50 to \$55**.

Extended Care Pricing

We are offering before and after care pricing on a **weekly basis** instead of on a daily basis. The cost of before or after care increased from **\$35 per week to \$40 per week**. The cost of before AND after care increased from **\$70 per week to \$80 per week**.

<u>If I pick up late one day, would I be charged for an entire week of before</u> <u>or after care?</u>

No, we understand life happens! If you consistently drop off early or pick up late, then we will charge your account for the weekly before or after care charge.

Cancellation Policy

We have added a more well-defined policy for cancellations: "The registration fee is non-refundable. Cancellations or changes during the camp season requires at least 2 weeks (14 days) notice prior to the week that you are looking to cancel. Any cancellations with less than a 2 week notice, the camp tuition will not be refunded."

<u>"Mini Camp"</u>

We operate our last two weeks of the summer as "Mini Camp" due to the loss of staff who work full-time, head back to college, or start pre-season activities. As a result, we have less camper spots available overall and must modify programming to adjust staffing needs.



2024 Camp Garrett AgEducation Track FAQs

Can we sign up for the AgEd track one week and Camp Garrett another week?

Yes, absolutely! This will be reflected in the registration form. As long as your camper(s) are between the **ages of 8 & 12**, your child will be able to switch between the two programs weekly. Please note that you cannot sign up for Camp Garrett AND the AgEd Track within the same week.

If we have a concern and our child attends the AgEd Track, who should we <u>contact?</u>

Is there anything different with billing?

The only difference with billing is the cost. If you would like your camper(s) to attend the AgEd Track program the weekly cost is **\$530**, compared to the Camp Garrett weekly cost of **\$382**. Before and After Care will now be billed weekly (rather than daily).

<u>If my camper attends the AgEd track program, will they be with the same</u> <u>counselors all day?</u>

Yes, your camper(s) will be with the same counselors throughout the day!

How is the safety of campers ensured during agricultural activities?

At the start of a new Camp week, each morning, and prior to working with Animals and/or tools, Campers will learn, discuss, and practice established safety rules & behaviors. These expectations are exhibited by Campers & Staff, throughout all interactions with the Animals, and is part of what Campers learn during the Ag. Ed. Track.

2024 Camp Garrett AgEducation Track FAQs

How are allergies & medical conditions managed within the AgEd Track program?

The Camp Garrett Nurse will support the AgEd Track program campers. All medications will be stored in a locked box at the Main Lodge's nurse office; additionally, nonprescription medicines are also kept at the Barn, in a locked box. If there is a medical emergency, the Camp Nurse has access to a gator to attend to campers on the property.

Is there a limit to the number of participants in the AgEd Track program?

Yes, we have a maximum of 16 participants, per week, to ensure safety.

Is there anything different my camper should bring for the AgEd Track program?

Yes: We recommend hiking or rain boots and pants or tall socks (for chores); Campers can change into shorts after morning activities, but long socks or pants are recommended for when working with the Animals. They also help us to catch ticks more quickly! Extra (closed-toe) shoes to wear after chores, for the rest of the day's activities. Hat and/or Sun gear; Campers will spend most of the day outside.

<u>My camper will turn 8 in the middle of the summer, can they register for a week of</u> <u>AgEd, once they turn 8?</u>

In order to register for the Agriculture Education Track program, your camper must be 8years old before the summer starts (June 1).
